

AMENDED ORDINANCE NO.2-99
FRACKVILLE BOROUGH

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF FRACKVILLE, SCHUYLKILL COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 10, PART 3, SECTION 303 OF THE BOROUGH'S STORAGE OF NUISANCE VEHICLE ORDINANCES TO EXCLUDE LAWFULLY OPERATING SALVORS OR BUSINESS ENTERPRISES WHEN SUCH STORAGE IS NECESSARY TO THE OPERATION OF SUCH BUSINESS WHEN STORING SUCH VEHICLES FOR LESS THAN THREE MONTHS AND ALLOWING PERMITS IN CIRCUMSTANCES OVER THREE MONTHS.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF FRACKVILLE, COUNTY OF SCHUYLKILL, PENNSYLVANIA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 303. STORAGE OF MOTOR VEHICLE NUISANCES PERMITTED IS HEREBY AMENDED AN REPLACED WITH THE FOLLOWING:

The Prohibition of Section 302 hereof shall not apply to vehicles otherwise lawfully stored in a private garage.


The Prohibition of Section 302 hereof shall not apply to the premises of a business enterprise otherwise operated in a lawful place and manner when necessary to the operation of such business enterprise as a storage place or depository maintained in a lawful place and manner, unless vehicles exceed a three month time period. At the end of the three month period, such business owner shall obtain a special permit from Borough Council for an extended time period set forth by the Borough Council pertaining to the circumstances involved.


The Prohibition of Section 303 hereof shall likewise not be applicable to salvors holding a current certificate of authorization issued by the Department of Transportation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, provided, however, that such salvor is operating in a lawful place and manner unless vehicle exceeds the three month time period. At that time, a special permit for extension must be approved by Borough Council in the same manner as above.
