ORDINANCE NO. 2003- | BOROUGH OF FRACKVILLE

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR RESIDENTIAL HANDICAP PARKING

BE IT ORDAINED by the governing body of the Borough of Frackville, County of Schuylkill, Pennsylvania:

SECTION I. Physical Requirements to Obtain Handicap Parking-

- 1. Medical needs of persons and/or persons living in dwellings who require two or more doctor and/or hospital visits per month; and,
- 2. Person or persons living in dwellings who are non-ambulatory and must rely solely on family-private vehicular transportation; and,
- 3. Person or persons shall have 90% to total loss of lower extremities and/or to such a degree which renders said person incapable of movement without personal attention from another; and/or,
- 4. Dwellings having person or persons who, because of a physical disability, is bedridden to such a degree which does not allow said person to possess a valid Pennsylvania driver's license.

SECTION II. Provisions for Obtaining Permit-.

- 1. Person or persons requesting such provisions shall request in writing, from Borough Council the permission to erect a handicap parking sign (at person's own expense). Persons or persons requesting such provisions may use the "Application For Handicap parking Sign, Borough Of Frackville" on file at Borough Council office.
- 2. Person or persons requesting such provisions must attach a doctor's note to said request stating patient's disability and or possible length of rehabilitation and/or disability.
- 3. Any documentation from medical sources must be updated every six (6) months whether the original notes stated time as indefinite and/or permanent.

SECTION III. Right of Council-

- Council reserves the right to re-evaluate at any time any parking privilege which 1. comes to their attention.
- Any violation and/or change in above guidelines will cancel any and all privilege 2. until further review by council.
