ORDINANCE NO. 2-13

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF FRACKVILLE AMENDING CHAPTER 15, MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, PART 4 - GENERAL PARKING REGULATIONS, SECTION 402 – PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES IN CERTAIN LOCATIONS; SECTION 406 – SPECIAL PURPOSE PARKING ZONES ESTABLISHED; AND SECTION 409 – RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING, ON PORTIONS OF CERTAIN STREETS

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by Council of the Borough of Frackville, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

**SECTION 402. PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES IN CERTAIN LOCATIONS** is hereby amended to include the following location:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Between</u>
Center Street	West	30 feet in both directions from the Borough driveway

All other parts of this Section shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 406. SPECIAL PURPOSE PARKING ZONES ESTABLISHED; PARKING OTHERWISE PROHIBITED** is hereby amended to include the following location:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Location</u>	<u>Authorized Purpose or Vehicle</u>
Center Street	West	30 feet south of the Borough Building driveway to Oak Street (unless otherwise restricted)	10-minute parking for loading/unloading & visits to municipal offices

All other parts of this Section shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 409. RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING** is hereby amended as follows:

Subsection 3, Criteria. (A.) and (B.) are rescinded with the factors to remain in full force and effect.

Subsection 4, Designation of Residential Permit Parking Areas:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Between</u>
Center Street	East	Frack and Oak Streets
Center Street	East & West	From Oak Street south 200 feet

Signs shall be erected along the streets in each residential permit parking area, under which parking shall be by permit only.

Subsection 5, Application for Permit. . . .who resides on or is a proprietor of property immediately adjacent to a street or other location within a residential parking permit area – but limited to two per household. A separate application shall be required for each motor vehicle. . .

All other parts of this Section shall remain in full force and effect.

The remaining sections of the Ordinance adopted on December 14, 1998, shall remain in full force and effect.
