ORDINANCE NO. 2012-5

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF FRACKVILLE AMENDING SECTIONS 304, 404, AND 510 OF CHAPTER 15 – MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC – IMPOSING CERTAIN PARKING AND TRUCK TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS AND RELATED TO PARKING FINES

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by Council of the Borough of Frackville, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

Section 304. Truck Traffic Restricted on Certain Streets

- 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to drive a motor vehicle having an unloaded weight of more than four tons (8,000 lbs.) in both directions upon Arch Street from Lehigh Avenue (S.R. 61) to Line Street except for purposes of making local deliveries to or pickups from premises located along said Arch Street.
- 2. Any person who violates this Section shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars and costs.

Section 404. Parking of Trucks, Buses, and Certain Other Vehicles Prohibited in Certain Locations

It shall be unlawful for any person to park, or to allow to remain parked, upon any street or highway within the Borough any motor vehicle having an unloaded weight of more than four tons (8,000 lbs.).

Section 510. Ticketing of Vehicles Parked Unlawfully; Effect of Payment Within 48 Hours

... 2. Any person who violates any provision of this Section shall also be informed that the fine may be reduced if he/she reports to the Borough's Police Department and pays the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars within 48 hours of the issuance of the violation.

The remaining sections of the Ordinance adopted on December 14, 1998, shall remain in full force and effect.
