



2025 FRACKVILLE COMMUNITY POOL RULES

NOTE – The Pool Complex is protected by twenty-four (24) hour video surveillance and on entering you agree to be recorded.

No one is permitted in the pool unless a lifeguard is on duty and on the pool deck.

No outside food or beverages are allowed except under special conditions for a rental or except for infant bottles or infant food.

Patrons must use showers at the pool before swimming.

The “kiddie pool area” shall be used only by small children and the person supervising them. Lifeguards may limit use of other features using their discretion.

No chairs of any kind will be permitted in the water sections of the pool. Chairs will be permitted on the cement and grass sections of the facility only.

No running, horseplay, riding on shoulders, dunking or fighting in the pool area.

No jumping from the island to the deck.

No jumping over or from the island.

No diving from the deck into the swimming pool.

No hanging on ropes or lines.

No glass containers are permitted in the facility.

No animals are permitted in the facility except service animals. Service animals should not enter the water.

No littering! All garbage must be disposed of in proper receptacles.

Children 10 years of age and under must be in the supervision of an adult, guardian or authorized babysitter that is 18 years or older at all times.

Pool personnel are not babysitters. Unattended children and their negligent parents will be asked to leave the pool.

No pushing lifeguards in the water.

No contact with the lifeguard chairs of any kind, including pushing, moving, flipping, tipping, toppling, etc.

Guests who cannot swim must remain in the shallow end of the pool at all times. A deep-water swim test may be conducted by staff to determine if the patron is safe in deep water.

Personal flotation devices and children's bathing suits with built in non-inflatable flotation devices are allowed. Children wearing these devices must always be within arm's reach of an adult guardian or authorized babysitter.

Inflatable flotation aids must be kept in water less than five feet deep and may be prohibited if the pool is crowded. Balls and other pool toys are permitted in the shallow end only when the pool is not crowded.

Upon leaving the pool you must get stamped by the front desk or pay the admission fee to get back in.

Alcoholic beverages, tobacco, vaping or smoking is not permitted on any part of the property. Narcotics are against the law anywhere. Individuals who appear to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs are prohibited from using the facility and will be reported to the authorities.

The Borough of Frackville is not responsible for, is not insured for, and will not reimburse guests for property loss or damage while visiting the facility.

All items brought into the pool area may be searched at any time by the Frackville Police Department.

*Patrons must respect the actions and directions of all pool personnel. Disobeying and disrespecting pool staff will not be tolerated and may result in being asked to leave the facility.

Health regulations

Spitting, spouting water, blowing the nose and or discharging bodily fluids into the pool is prohibited.

Anyone who has an area of exposed sub-epidermal tissue, open blisters, cuts etc. is advised not to use the pool.

All diaper age children must use swim diapers.

Please use the diaper changing stations in the bath houses. Do not change disposable diapers poolside.

Only proper swimming attire will be allowed. Street clothes are not permitted in the pool, nor is a thong, in order to keep the pool as a family friendly environment.

Because this is a tobacco free environment, tobacco users must remain 30 feet from the entrance to the complex if using tobacco.

Float accessory rules

No standing on floats.

No jumping from floats.

No more than two people on float at any time.

Diving board rules

Non-swimmers are not permitted on the diving board at any time.

Only one person is permitted on the diving board at any time.

The diver must wait until the previous diver has reached the second ladder (ladder in dive area furthest from diving board).

The diver must proceed directly to the second ladder (ladder in dive area furthest from the diving board) after completing the dive, and exit the dive area immediately.

Line skipping is strictly prohibited.

For your safety do not:

- Wear metal objects, jewelry, keys, watches, glasses, goggles etc.
- Dive from the board if you have physical health impairment.
- No backflips

Due to health risks use of diving board is not recommended for pregnant women.

*Violators will be immediately discharged and may lose water slide privileges.

Water slide rules

Non-swimmers are not permitted on the slide at any time.

No floatation devices on slide at any time.

Only one person is permitted to go down the slide at any time.

Please exit in front of slide immediately after each side.

Enter and exit slide flume feet first only, seated or lying on your back.

Line skipping is strictly prohibited.

The maximum weight per user is 250 pounds.

The minimum height for users is 44 inches.

For your safety do not:

- Wear metal objects, jewelry, keys, watches, glasses, goggles etc.
- Ride the slide if you have physical health impairment.
- Run on stairway or around slide deck.
- Stop or stand in slide flumes.
- Dive from end of slide flume into pool.

Due to health risks use of pool slide is not recommended for pregnant women.

*Violators will be immediately discharged and may lose water slide privileges.

Closing policy

During the season the pool may close if one or more of the following occur:

- The pool may close or be closed early in the case of inclement weather or low attendance.
- The Frackville Community Pool will require immediate closure of the pool in the event that lightning or thunder is present in or around the area. The pool will remain closed until 30 minutes past the last visible lightning strike or episode of thunder.
- The pool will be closed if the air temperature is 60 degrees or below.
- The staffing levels fall below the current regulations.

Violation of the rules

Violations of the Frackville Community Pool rules will result in the following corrective actions not necessarily in this order and for a length of time determined by pool staff.

- Warning
- Benched
- Suspended
- Expelled

If a child is benched by pool staff they must remain there until the pool staff releases them. In the event of any parent removing the child prior to the pool staff releasing them, the child and parent will be asked to leave the pool.

Anyone who has been dismissed from the pool for disciplinary reasons may have their privileges revoked for the remainder of the season without a refund.
