

ORDINANCE NO. 2001-2
FRACKVILLE BOROUGH

AN ORDINANCE VACATING OR ABANDONING A PORTION OF A PUBLIC STREET IN THE BOROUGH OF FRACKVILLE, SCHUYLKILL COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, A PORTION OF THE STREET KNOWN AS HICKORY STREET.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Borough Council of the Borough of Frackville to vacate and abandon a portion of the following street as it is hereafter more particularly described;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Frackville as follows:

SECTION 1. The following street as designated is hereby vacated and abandoned as a public street in the Borough of Frackville.

If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Borough of Frackville this ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

SECTION 4.

This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after enactment, as provided by law.
