The property at 300 -302 S. Broad Mountain Avenue is really bad. The Mayor is going to contact the health officer .


Mr. Jim Flail volunteered his services as a health officer free of charge to the borough.



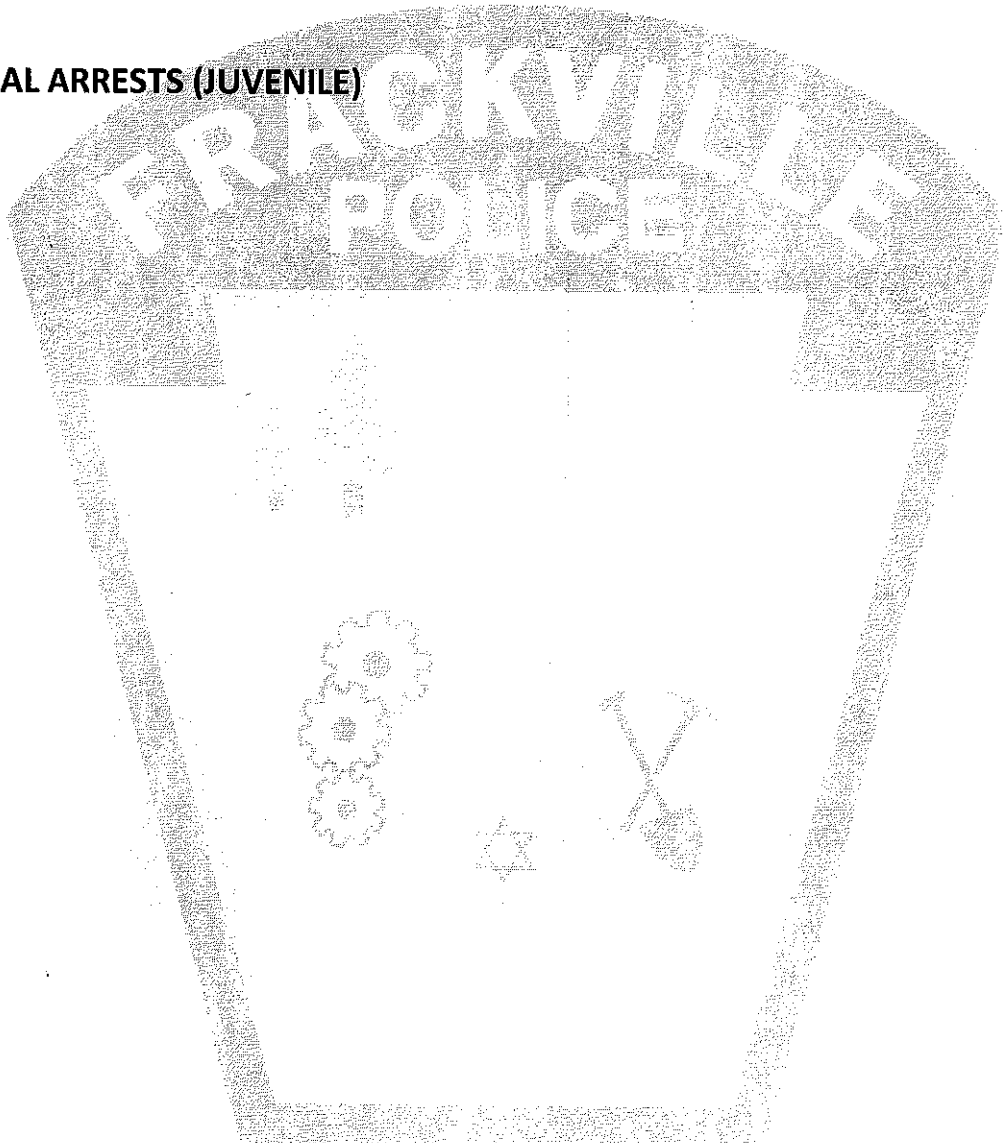



It is my understanding you cannot have another business that sells alcohol within 200 ft.

PARKING

- The proposed bar only has 4 parking spaces. There is no off-street parking. I feel their customers will use my private lot for parking. *And will be towed away they have no room for Handicap Parking also.*

SAFETY
