

ORDINANCE NO. 2001-6
FRACKVILLE BOROUGH

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF FRACKVILLE, SCHUYLKILL COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROHIBITING THE USE OF AEROSOL CANS WHICH PROPEL MATERIAL WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF FRACKVILLE AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF FRACKVILLE, COUNTY OF SCHUYLKILL, PENNSYLVANIA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

Section 1.1 – Aerosol Cans Which Propel Material:

No person in the Borough of Frackville shall utilize aerosol cans which propel material (commonly referred to as “silly string”) during the course of any public parades or events. It shall be unlawful under this Ordinance to sell such aerosol cans during any public parade or event and on any day immediately prior to a scheduled public parade or event.

SECTION II

Section 2.1 – Penalty for Violation:

Any person who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars no more than Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars and in default of payment to imprisonment for a term not to exceed thirty (30) days.

SECTION III

Section 3.1 – Repealer:

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are in consistence herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3.2 – Severability:

If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not effect sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Borough of Frackville that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

Section 3.3 – Effective Date:

This Ordinance shall become effective on this 14th day of May, 2001, by the Council of the Borough of Frackville, in lawful session duly assembled.
