FRACKVILLE BOROUGH COUNCIL
REGULAR MEETING
MARCH 11, 2015

The regular meeting of the Frackville Borough Council opened with the "Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag". Vice President Zuber presided. Council members Creasy, Domalakes, Gotshall, Morgan, along with Mayor Phillips, Secretary/Treasurer, Solicitor Semanchik and a few citizens were in attendance.

Church of God – Frackville, PA


The church is requesting pastoral parking. The solicitor said in the past council has not designated pastoral parking. Private parking was recommended to the church.



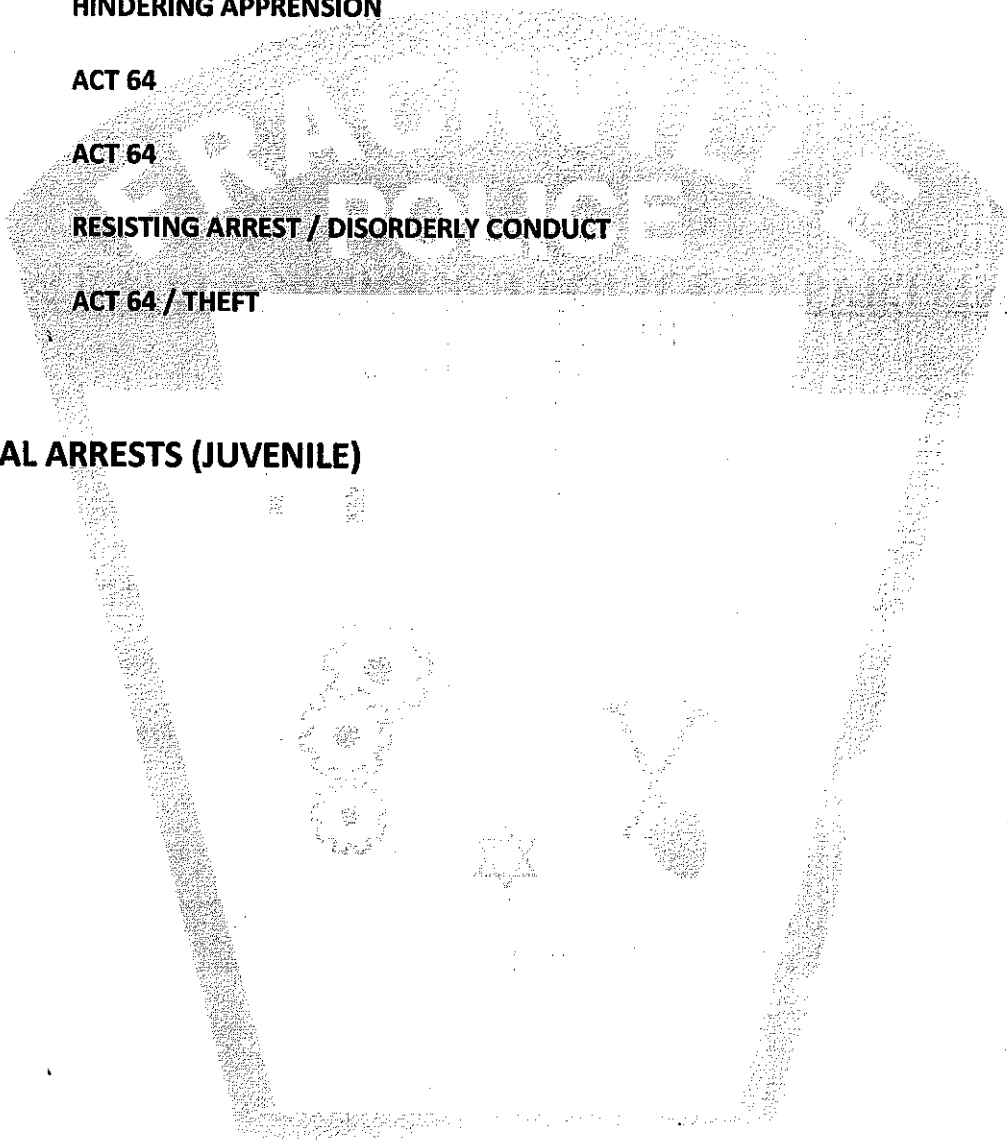
