

**BOROUGH OF FRACKVILLE  
SPECIAL MEETING  
NOVEMBER 19, 2013**

A special meeting of Frackville Borough Council opened with the "Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag". President Jordan presided. Council members Domalakes, Gotshall, Klevis, and Zuber, along with Mayor Phillips, Solicitor Semanchik, and citizen Judy Ragazinsky were in attendance.

The Solicitor reported that Council members met in executive session beginning at 5:15 p.m., which lasted until 5:25 p.m., during which it discussed a personnel issue and a property issue.

**PERSONNEL REPORT**

The Solicitor reported that a hearing was held on Thursday, November 14, 2013 by him, a Hearing Committee of Council (Jordan, Domalakes, and Klevis), and a member of the police department with legal counsel, regarding the continuation of entitlement to Heart & Lung benefits. The Solicitor presented a Resolution for consideration. On motion by Ms. Domalakes, seconded by Mr. Zuber, all in favor 5-0, Resolution adopted.

**PROPERTY REPORT**

The Solicitor reported having been contacted as to a Mortgage dated March 7, 2006, filed against property located at 114 South Lehigh Avenue as part of the Home Improvement Grant Program. Since more than five years have passed, this Mortgage is to be forgiven/satisfied, and he will take the steps necessary to accomplish this.
